

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS (V 1.0)

All character sheets are laid out for double-sided printing on 11"x17" paper. Currently the only exceptions to this are the sheet for the bladebound magus' black blade and the Spellbook that only goes up to 6th level spells.

For easy printing I would suggest taking a flash-drive (or CD) with the PDF files to your local Fed-Ex Office (or Kinko's or similar copy shop). The staff at your local establishment should have no problem printing the files out for you. Expect a double-side 11"x17" printed in B&W to run you about 50¢

11"x17"(double-sided)

Normal paper

8.5"x11"(double-sided)

Long edge binding
Fit-to-page (still not important)

8.5"x11"(single-sided)

Fit-to-page (still not important)

8.5"x11"(Initiative Card Set)

Cardstock
Black and white printing
!!Do Not Fit-to-page!! (it is actually important for this one not to be scaled since some printer may scale different sections of the page differently, the cards you end up with might not all be the same size)

GENERAL INFORMATION (V1.0)

The Generic Character Folio is suitable for use by any character class or combination of classes and includes a handy advancement tracker and magic item tracker included on the inside portion.

If you are planning on running a spell-casting character then you will need a Generic Character Folio and the Spell Folio sheet that goes with your chosen class. Both of these sheets are double-sided 11"x17" sheets. If you have a spellbook or formula book then you'll need a copy of that as well. The 9th level spellbook is 11"x17" double-sided, but the 6th level spellbook is 8.5"x11" double-sided.

The Initiative Tracker Cards should be printed on cardstock to increase their longevity, you'll probably only need one copy of the first page of cards (the ones for your PCs), but you'll probably want at least two copies of the second page of cards (the one for groups of similar monsters).

I usually fill out the initiative cards for all encounters in an upcoming gaming session a day or two ahead of time so that encounters can be set a up and run even faster.
